PRIVACY POLICY

WBS is committed to protecting your privacy in order to provide you the best possible online experience. WBS has put into effect this Privacy Policy to protect your Personally Identifiable Information.

WBS collects Personally Identifiable Information about our members only during setup for the broadband service. This information includes, but not limited to, member's name, address, telephone number, and e-mail address. WBS will not disclose to any outside parties any personally identifiable information obtained during this registration process. WBS contractors or other companies that perform services on its behalf, will be required that they protect your personally identifiable information consistent with this policy.

Use of cookies by WBS is limited to your navigation of our website, entry into any WBS contest, participation in a survey or changes you make in your personal account manager. Data we collect from cookies is used in aggregate to give WBS demographic information on our entire membership. This information is used solely to help improve our service.

WBS monitors its network to insure its integrity. This information is used in aggregate. This information will not be disclosed to any outside parties nor use any personally identifiable information regarding Internet usage unless compelled by a court order or subpoena.

WBS will not read your outgoing or incoming e-mail, private chat, or instant messages unless compelled by a court order or subpoena to disclose this information. WBS will store e-mail messages for a brief period on WBS servers until they are deleted by the member from WBS servers. WBS may delete messages or accounts that are considered dormant by the applicable policy.

WBS does not target children or teenagers for the collection of personally identifiable information. WBS encourages parents and guardians to spend time online with their children and to participate in and monitor their internet usage. All minors should have parental consent before using the internet or disclosing any personally identifiable information online.

WBS may also use personally identifiable information to investigate and prevent potentially unlawful activity or activity that threatens the network or violates the customer agreement for service.

WBS has in place security and policy guidelines to protect your personally identifiable information from unauthorized access.
